 - Estimated cost \$1,500

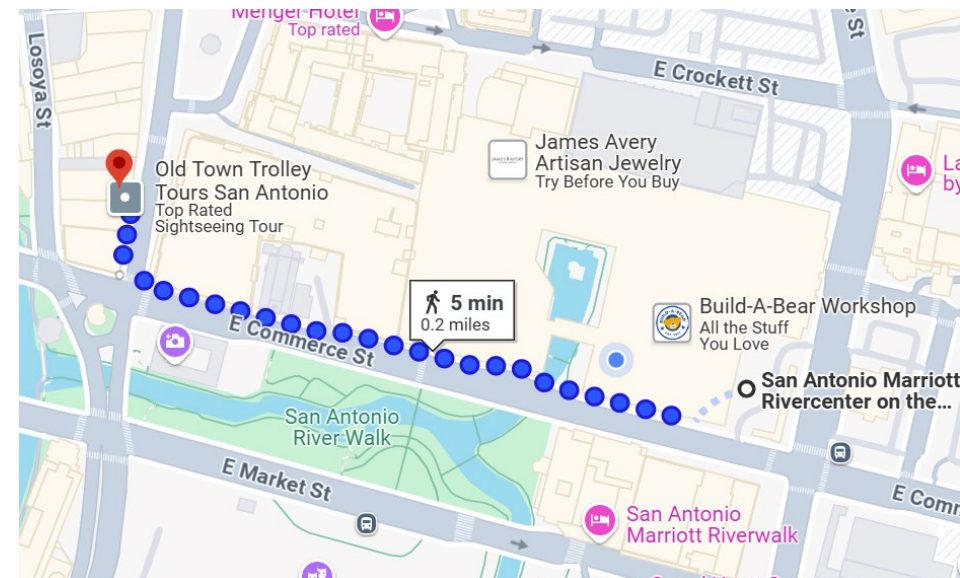
Sample Policies
